Overview:

This qualification is designed for people who work with children and young people but would also be suitable for those seeking a career change.

Who would benefit from this qualification?

This qualification is aimed at nursery assistants, crèche workers and special educational needs assistants working in a supporting role

Course Content

You will need to complete seven units, six of which are core units:

- Help to keep children safe
- Supporting children's development
- Use support to develop own practice in children's care, learning and development
- Prepare and maintain environments to meet children's needs
- Support children's play and learning
- Contribute to positive relationships

You will then complete one optional unit from a choice of four including supporting the development of babies and supporting children's educational and recreational needs.

Entry Requirements:

You will be required to submit two suitable references, complete a satisfactory interview which includes completing initial diagnostic assessment in literacy and numeracy for which you should achieve level 1. As part of the Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) disclosure check, all courses which include a work placement require you to submit any ONE of the following documents at interview for example a passport, birth certificate or driving licence.
