Overview

A grounding in basic skills, knowledge and understanding of common manufacturing practices, along with a grasp of safe working practices, are essential for anyone seeking to build a career in engineering/manufacturing.

Who would benefit from this qualification?

This qualification is aimed at candidates who perform a general manufacturing role. This involves a range of functions including controlling a process, transferring materials, recording and reporting inspection and test results.

Course Content

Students will complete the following core unit:

- Complying with Statutory Regulations and Organisational Safety Requirements

Plus one from the following

- Promoting Effective Working Relationships
- Contributing to Effective Team Working

In addition they will also have to complete 3 optional units and 1 job specific unit, tailored to the individual's role.

Entry Requirements:

There are no formal entry requirements for candidates undertaking this NVQ, however employers must ensure that candidates have the potential and opportunity to gain evidence for the qualification in the work place.
