Overview

The Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools NVQs are designed to reflect the activities of those who provide direct support for teaching and learning in any type of school – primary (including foundation stage), secondary, and special or pupil referral units.

Who would benefit from this qualification?

This NVQ has been developed to reflect changes in support staff roles following implementation of workforce reform. They still cover the role of teaching assistants but have been broadened in scope to include new roles and responsibilities such as cover supervision, exam invigilation, pastoral care and others.

Course Content

The NVQs can be used by all learning staff whether they are:

- Full or part-time (16+ hours per week)
- Permanent or temporary
- Employed by the school or local authority
- School-based or peripatetic, or
- Working in a maintained, non-maintained or independent school.

This NVQ could be used by volunteer workers (Not for Apprenticeships) within the school provided they cover a sufficient breadth of responsibilities for supporting teaching and learning.

Entry Requirements:

There are no formal entry requirements for candidates undertaking this NVQ, however employers must ensure that candidates have the potential and opportunity to gain evidence for the qualification in the work place.
