



CIEH Level 3 Award in of Risk Assessment Principles and Practice

The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations include an explicit requirement for risk to be assessed and recorded where more than five people are employed. This popular course is designed to enable delegates to understand the basis of risk assessment and carry out such assessments. It is suitable for directors, managers, supervisor's safety officers and safety representatives. Successful candidates will receive a Level 3 certificate from the Chartered Institute of Environmental Health following their completion of a work-based risk study time following the course.

NB As some experience of health and safety is expected for this course to enable delegates to successfully complete the practical, beginners should consider the alternative L2 course.
