IOSH MANAGING SAFELY

Managing Safely is for those required to manage safely and effectively in compliance with both their organisation's policy and best practice in health and safety. It is designed to inform attendees on the practical actions needed to handle health and safety in any sector and in any organisation.

Course Content

The course includes topic areas:

- Safety management systems, the role of risk assessment and how safety management links with other aspects of management, legal requirements and the social environment.
- Reactive monitoring including which incidents have to be reported, checking that reports are being made, recording reported incidents, conducting investigations, recording results and analysing records.
- Risk assessment and risk control, including making an inventory of sources of hazards, identifying hazards associated with each course, rating risks, selecting workplace precautions and recording results of risk assessments and reviews.
- Preparing and using active monitoring checklists, implementing schedules for active monitoring, recording results and analysing records.
- Safety policy, organising and conducting a management review of the safety management system and preparing a health and safety audit.
- Identifying relevant legislation and obtaining advice and guidance on compliance.
- Managing the sources of hazards addressed in Working Safely.

Assessment Method

Practical and written assessments which must be submitted after the training course.

Certification

The course is accredited by the Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH), successful candidates receive formal certification and are then able to join IOSH as an associate member.
