



IOSH Working Safely

Working Safely is for people working at any level in any sector who needs a grounding in the essentials of health and safety. Everyone at work needs and understanding of why they need to 'work safely' and this course offers this.

Working Safely will help to focus individuals on why health and safety is important and how individuals can make a real difference to the wellbeing of themselves and others through changing their behaviour.

Content

- Introducing working safely – empathises that human experience behind accident statistics and the importance of personal responsibility
- Defining hazard and risk – focusing on the six broad hazard groups delegates are asked to think about the hazards and risks they face in their own workplace
- Identifying common hazards – all the main issues are covered in this module. Each area is backed with examples and recognisable scenarios
- Improving safety performance – this section focus on how everyone plays a part in health and safety and encourages delegates to contribute to processes that are commonly seen as the responsibility of the manager or supervisor
- Protecting our environment – a short introduction to waste and pollution and how team members can get involved in reducing environmental impact
