

# CELTA with PTLLS

## (The Certificate in English Language Teaching to Adults)

**CAMBRIDGE INTERNATIONAL CENTRE**

### Course Overview

The CELTA course involves a minimum of 120 contact hours. This includes input on teaching methodology and language awareness, 6 assessed hours of teaching practice with feedback, supervised lesson planning and tutorials, 6 hours classroom observation of experienced teachers and four written assignments. A portfolio is completed as a record of work done. (Candidates will need to spend further time on pre-session tasks, lesson preparation, completion of assignments as well as background reading and research).

The PTLLS module requires two further assignments.

### Course Content

There are five units of learning:

- Learners and teachers, and the teaching and learning context
- Language analysis and awareness
- Language skills: reading, listening, speaking and writing
- Planning and resources for different teaching contexts
- Developing teaching skills and professionalism

### Entry Requirements

Age 20+ (18 + will be considered). Previous teaching experience is not required but may be helpful. Trainees must have a standard of education equivalent to that required for entry into higher education. Competence in both spoken and written English and good language awareness, and for non-native speakers, a high level of fluency and accuracy.

### Assessment

Assessment takes place throughout the course and considers the trainee's overall performance. There are two assessed components:

1. Being able to demonstrate successful planning and teaching
2. Completion of four classroom-related written assignments

All results are approved by Cambridge ESOL with standards monitored by an external assessor. Full attendance on the course is required.
