An Art & Design Lecturer at Cambridge Regional College has been selected to exhibit her pottery work at the high profile show, Origin: The London Craft Fair, in October.

Rachel Dormor, 32, was awarded funding from the Arts Council to help with the development of her show. She has also showcased her porcelain work at 'Art in Clay' in August this year. Further exhibitions have been held at galleries such as Cambridge Contemporary Art and Serena Hall Gallery, Southwold. Furthermore, Rachel helped to set up the White House Arts in Chesterton where she teaches ceramics.

As well as running her own business, 'Rachel Dormor Ceramics', and teaching at CRC and White House Arts, Rachel is due to begin an MA in Ceramic Design at Staffordshire University in October. She said, "I am looking forward to showing my work to a new audience and to being able to bring my professional and industry experience to teaching".

Rachel Dormor Ceramics, based in Cambridge, was established in 2001, with the help of the Prince's Trust. Her award-winning tableware has been featured in homes and interior magazines including *Livingetc* and *BBC Good Homes*. Her work has been sold through *Red Direct*, as well as mail order companies such as *R K Alliston*.
