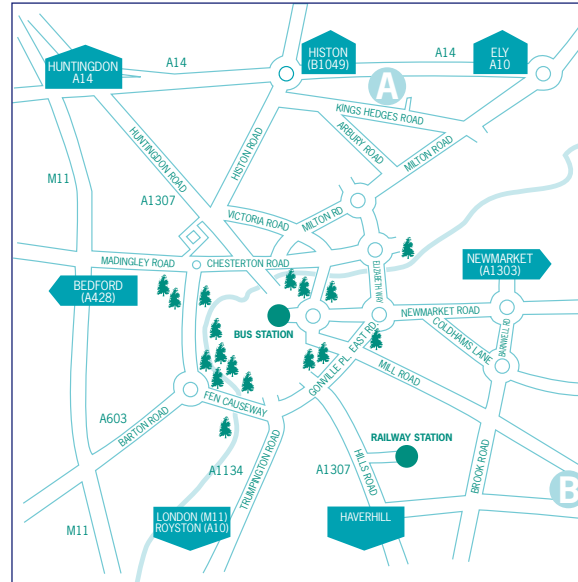

## The Welfare Service

Do you need to speak to someone in confidence about difficulties you are having which may be affecting your progress and attendance at College?

The Welfare Adviser can help students with a range of issues including applying for benefits or other financial help, bullying/harassment, course concerns, accommodation, homelessness, being a young parent, mum-to-be or parent-to-be. If the Adviser cannot provide the necessary assistance, they will refer you to someone who can.

The Adviser also has information from local and national organisations on a wide range of welfare issues.
