

Transfer Arrangements to Cambridge Regional College

If you are a higher education student at Cambridge Regional College, or another college or university, and you've changed your mind about what and where you want to study, we are here to help.

Transfers between courses at Cambridge Regional College

If you are a student at Cambridge Regional College and wish to transfer to a different course, our team considers every request on a case by case basis.

We ask that you meet with our Careers Team to ensure that the course you are transferring to the right course. A discussion will be held with relevant Curriculum Managers and if the transfer is deemed appropriate an internal transfer will be made. When considering your request, we will consider prior learning and experience and when the course started.

There may financial implications when changing course, should course costs differ. This will be discussed with you at your transfer meeting.

Transfer to Cambridge Regional College

Depending on our entry criteria, your prior learning, experience and when the course started, we may be able to transfer you directly to a relevant course here.

We will discuss your situation and provide advice and guidance on your options.

Please note that it is within the College's discretion whether to offer a place once a course has commenced.

Transfers from a Cambridge Regional College course to another HE provider

We not have a formal arrangement for the transfer of students wishing to study their programme at another provider.

If you are a Cambridge Regional College student and wish to withdraw from your course and continue at another provider, it is the new provider's responsibility to consider the transfer request in accordance with their own admissions policies and procedures. Please talk to our Careers Team if you need any information, advice or guidance.
